General Conditions

No new course(s) shall be started or an ongoing course(s) shall be discontinued without t prior approval of the AICTE.

The intake capacity in any of the approved course(s) shall not be increased or varied with

the prior approval of the AICTE.

Adequate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurr 3. and non-recurring nature as prescribed by the AICTE, from time to time.

All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per the AICTE nor 4.

prescribed from time to time.

- Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experier 5. and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salar and allowances regularly and in time.
- The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within overall criteria/limits as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
- Admissions shall be made according to the regulations and directions of the AICTE for su admissions in the respective technical institution or university.
- The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society e 8. shall be followed by the Institution.
- Institution by virtue of the approval by AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to rece financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Governments.
- 10. Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as prescribed by the Compet Authority.
- 11. The Accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any ager authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or ; body authorised by it.
- 12. The Institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AIC
- 13. Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICTE for ensur maintenance of standards.
- 14. The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Officer from time to time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions laid down by the AICTE.

Additional Conditions for Pvt. and Grant-in-Aid technical institutions:

- 15. The Governing Body of the institution shall be constituted, and its Chairman shall be appoint as per the guidelines of AICTE.
- The institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other hig charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
- The Institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continue monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the AICTE. There shall be an evaluat of the Institution in a plan period by the AICTE.
- The institution should create an Endowment fund jointly in the name of the institution and concerned State Authority to the tune of 30% of the projected peak annual recurring expendit or as prescribed by the State Govt./UT or Rs. 10 lakhs, whichever is more.

Institute of Technlogy (Poly.) Palus, Tal-Palus, Dist - Sangli

Specific conditions:

- 1. The infrastructural and other facilities in terms of clas rooms, tutorial rooms, laboratories. Workshops, library etc as per AICTE norms for 1st year classes should be readprior commencement of session.
- 2. The infrastructural and other facilities in terms of clas rooms, tutorial rooms, laboratories. workshops, librar etc., as per AICTE norms for subsequent year classes shoul be ready atleast three months in advance before actual star of classes of those years.
- 3. Principal having AICTE approval experience and qualifications should be in position prior admissions. 03 lecturer in each discipline should be appointed prior admissions.
- The teaching faculty strength should be available for each year of study well before the commencement of the classe and should be progressively raised by appointing HOD. So Lecturers and Lecturers as per AICTE norms maintaining cade proportion.
- 5. The Society/ Trust should create an endowment fund joint in the name of the Institution and the Director of Technic Education, Maharashtra to the tune of 30% of the project peak annual recurring expenditure or as prescribed by Sta Govt. or Rs. 10 lakhs, whichever is higher, prior admissions.
- AICTE pay scales should be granted to teaching and no teaching faculty.
- 7. The courses/ institute should be started in its "q 1 a new" premises.
- 8. The facilities created by the institution may be verified the Expert Committee of AICTE before admissions are made ensure minimum facilities to conduct the courses.
- 9. Society/ Trust/ Institute should provide and improve facilities and run the college as per the commitments stain their project report.
- 10. Certified documents regarding investments/ expenditure financial status should be maintained separately for institute and are subject to verification by AICTE.
